Bids must be submitted in person and mailed or faxed bids will not be accepted. Plaintiff's representation must submit all paperwork in accordance with *Bidding and Day of Sale Information* located in the rules section of our website.

ANY PROPERTIES UPON WHICH CONTESTED written bids are received by 11:00 will go to the oral auction at the hour of 11:05 am or as soon thereafter as possible, and at such time any person present may bid at oral auction.

ALL BIDS ARE FINAL, no bid received may be withdrawn or amended after being duly received and recorded by Sheriff's personnel conducting the sale.

ALL BID MONIES AND COSTS ARE DUE PAYABLE NO LATER THAN **3:00 PM** ON THE DAY OF SALE. Default of payment reverts property back to the PLAINTIFF at time of sale.
