Starting with the February 2011 Sheriff Sale, Lieberman Technologies LLC, Contractor for the Wabash County Sheriff Sales, will, provide the ad copy to the Wabash Plain Dealer. The Wabash Plain Dealer will compute the rates based on the data in the ad supplied by Lieberman. The Wabash Plain Dealer will then notify Lieberman of the rates. Lieberman will post those rates on the sheriff sale web site

It is the attorney's responsibility to make timely payments to the Wabash Plain Dealer. If payment is not made, the Wabash Plain Dealer might not run the ad. If the ad is not run, the sale will not be held.

If the attorney wishes to place a foreclosure ad in the North Manchester News-Journal, it is the attorney's responsibility to take the action described in the paragraph above. Also, the attorney should instruct Lieberman to not place the ad in the Wabash Plain Dealer.
